

## ABOUT THE COMPOSER

Ambrož Čopi (Bovec / Slovenia, January 11, 1973) is a representative of the younger generation of Slovene composers. After finishing the Music High School in Ljubljana, he entered Academy of Music in Ljubljana as a student of piano and composition, the later of which he studied under the tutelage of prof. Dane Škerl, graduating in 1996. He continued his musical education with professors Uroš Rojko and Janos Vajda.

Čopi's compositions have been awarded top prizes at numerous competitions; many others were commissioned for competitions and festivals. His compositions are performed by numerous slovenian and foreign choirs, various artists as Jože Kotar and Mirjam Kalin, the Slovenian Philharmonic Orchestra and the Slovene Radio-Television Orchestra from Ljubljana. After many years of fruitful collaboration with the Academic Mixed Choir Tone Tomšič from Ljubljana, a CD with author's compositions, titled *Lirčni akvareli* (*Lyrical Aquarels*) was published. With the Čarnice vocal group a CD with author's arrangements of folk-songs for high voices *So ptičice še snivale* (*The Birdies Were Still Sleeping*) was published in 2007.

Since September 1999 he has been dedicated to teaching at the Arts Gymnasium in Koper, Slovenia, where he teaches music subjects and composition. He delivers lectures at workshops in Slovenia and abroad. Čopi was also the successful leader of the Vladimir Lovec Chamber Orchestra of the Music School and Arts Gymnasium and of other choirs: the Female Chamber Choir Iskra from Bovec (1992-2001), the Chamber Choir Nova Gorica (1998-2004), the Mixed Youth Choir of the Koper Gymnasium (1999-2002, 2007- ) and the Mixed Choir Obala Koper (1998-2007). Currently, he is the conductor of the Academic Choir of the University of Primorska (2004- ). With his choirs he has won the highest awards at home and abroad. Čopi has won multiple special recognitions for his interpretations.

## O SKLADATELU

Ambrož Čopi (Bovec, 11.1.1973) je predstavnik mlajše slovenske skladateljske generacije. Po končani Srednji glasbeni in baletni šoli v Ljubljani je vpisal študij klavirja in kompozicije na Akademiji za glasbo v Ljubljani, kjer je najprej pod mentorstvom prof. Daneta Škerla leta 1996 z odliko diplomiral iz kompozicije, nato pa še dokončal specjalistični študij pod mentorstvom prof. Uroša Rojka. Svoje znanje je izpopolnjeval na mojstrskem tečaju pri Janusu Vajdu.

Še v času študija je za svoje uspehe prejel več nagrad: leta 1996 nagrado mladi glasbenik leta, leta 1996 Prešernovo nagrado Univerze v Ljubljani in priznanje občine Bovec. Njegove skladbe so bile nagrajene na številnih skladateljskih natečajih, mnoge so bile naročene za izvedbo na tekmovanjih in festivalih. Izdane so pri domačih in tujih založbah, izvajajo jih številni slovenski in tudi zahraniški umetniki ter orkestra Slovenske filharmonije in RTV Ljubljana.

1998. je izdal avtorsko zgoščenko »Lirčni akvareli«, plod dolgoletnega sodelovanja z APZ Tone Tomšič iz Ljubljane, s katerim je sodeloval sprva kot skladatelj, kasneje kot asistent dirigenta Stojana Kureta. Pri vokalni skupini Čarnice je Čopi leta 2007 izdal tudi priedbe ljudskih pesmi za visoke glasove »So ptičice še snivale«. Kot zborovodja je dosegal vidne uspehe z (ženskim) Komornim zborom Iskra iz Bovca (1992-2001), s Komornim zborom Nova Gorica (1998-2004), z Mešanim mladinskim pevskim zborom Gimnazije Koper (1999-2002, 2007- ) in z Mešanim pevskim zborom Obala iz Kopra (1998-2007).

Od septembra 1999 se posveča pedagoškemu delu na Umetniški gimnaziji Koper, kjer poučuje strokovne predmete, osnove kompozicije. Tam je vodil tudi Komorni orkester Glasbene šole in umetniške gimnazije Koper »Vladimir Lovec«. Kot predavatelj sodeluje na zborovskih seminarjih doma in v tujini. Trenutno vodi Akademski pevski zbor Univerze na Primorskem (2004- ). Z njim posega po najvišjih nagradah na tekmovanjih doma in v tujini. Za svoje interpretacije skladb je prejel številna posebna priznanja.
